

Create a One-Cell Table

Note: The original macro was designed for WPDOS 5.1 and has been converted to WordPerfect 6.x. It is included as ONECELL.WPM.

I use WordPerfect to write instruction manuals in which the directions have to be emphasized so they're different from the practice problems. I tried using text boxes, but you can't edit them directly on-screen. Instead, I wrote a macro that creates a one-cell table. The advantage to working in Tables is that you can edit them on-screen.

To play the macro, press (Alt-F10), type "onecell" and press (Enter). Type your text to insert into the table, then press (Down Arrow) to exit the table or press (Enter) to add more lines inside the table.
